
#### How to reach the conference venue?

#### By Car:

- · From Amsterdam or Rotterdam (A4), take the exit at the Prins Clausplein onto the A12, direction The Hague (Den Haag).
- · From Utrecht (A12), continue the highway to The Hague (Den Haag). Follow the sign 'Scheveningen', taking a left turn at the traffic lights at the end of the highway, and at the end of the road turn right onto the Koningskade. Follow this road until you see the sign 'Scheveningen Haven'. Take right and loop onto the overpass (Hubertus viaduct). Take right at the next traffic lights onto the Van Stolkweg (The Crowne Plaza Hotel is on your right hand side). Take right onto the Hogeweg and immediately left onto the Parkweg. Take a sharp left onto the Van Stolkweg. CPB is the red brick building on your right, Van Stolkweg 14.

#### By Public Transportation:

From railway station The Hague Hollands Spoor with tram line 1, direction
 Scheveningen, exit at tramstop Frankenslag.






From railway station The Hague Centraal Station with tram line 17, direction Statenkwartier, exit at tramstop Buitenhof, change to tram line 1 at tramstop Kneuterdijk and exit at tramstop Frankenslag.

#### By car:

- · From Amsterdam / Leiden (A44 / N44): follow Den Haag Centrum. At the traffic lights turn left to Voorburg / Leidschendam. Take the first road on the right (Bezuidenhoutseweg).
- From Utrecht (A12) / Rotterdam (A13) / Amsterdam (A4): At junction Prins Clausplein follow Voorburg / Den Haag. Take exit 2 Den Haag Centrum. Go straight on at next 2 traffic lights and at the third traffic light turn right (Bezuidenhoutseweg).

#### By train:

Bezuidenhoutseweg 73 is a short walk (approximately 200m) from The Hague Central Station (Den Haag Centraal). Turn right out of the main station entrance onto the Bezuidenhoutseweg.
